Pray that the Holy Spirit would kindle a fire in their hearts that will be everlasting. Pray for each to declare with their mouth, "Jesus is Lord" and believe in their hearts that God raised him from the dead. The Lay Director, Ben Savage, has chosen Romans 12:12 to guide the weekend. "Rejoice in hope, be patient in suffering, and persevere in prayer" (NRSV). "Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer" (NIV). The hardest part of this scripture for me is the directive in the middle. "Be patient in suffering or affliction." This is a very difficult command, not only for adults, but especially for the young men that may be hearing this for the first time.

To be patient in suffering means to endure difficulties without losing faith, hope, or integrity. It doesn't mean pretending pain doesn't exist or passively accepting every hardship—it's about trusting

that God is working, even when circumstances don't make sense. In the biblical context, patience in affliction is about:

1. Trusting God's timing, even when you want instant relief.
2. Staying faithful, rather than giving up or becoming bitter.
3. Learning endurance, because suffering often builds spiritual strength and empathy.

The Apostle Paul, who wrote this, faced persecution, imprisonment, and suffering for his faith. His words remind us that pain is temporary, but God's promises and love are constant and forever. Please prayerfully meditate on these words and pray for these young men to overcome any afflictions.

Please mark your calendars and set a reminder to attend in person. The Candlelight service is a highlight to all 3-day walks with Christ. **Your attendance will be an everlasting blessing.** I hope to see you all at Candlelight.

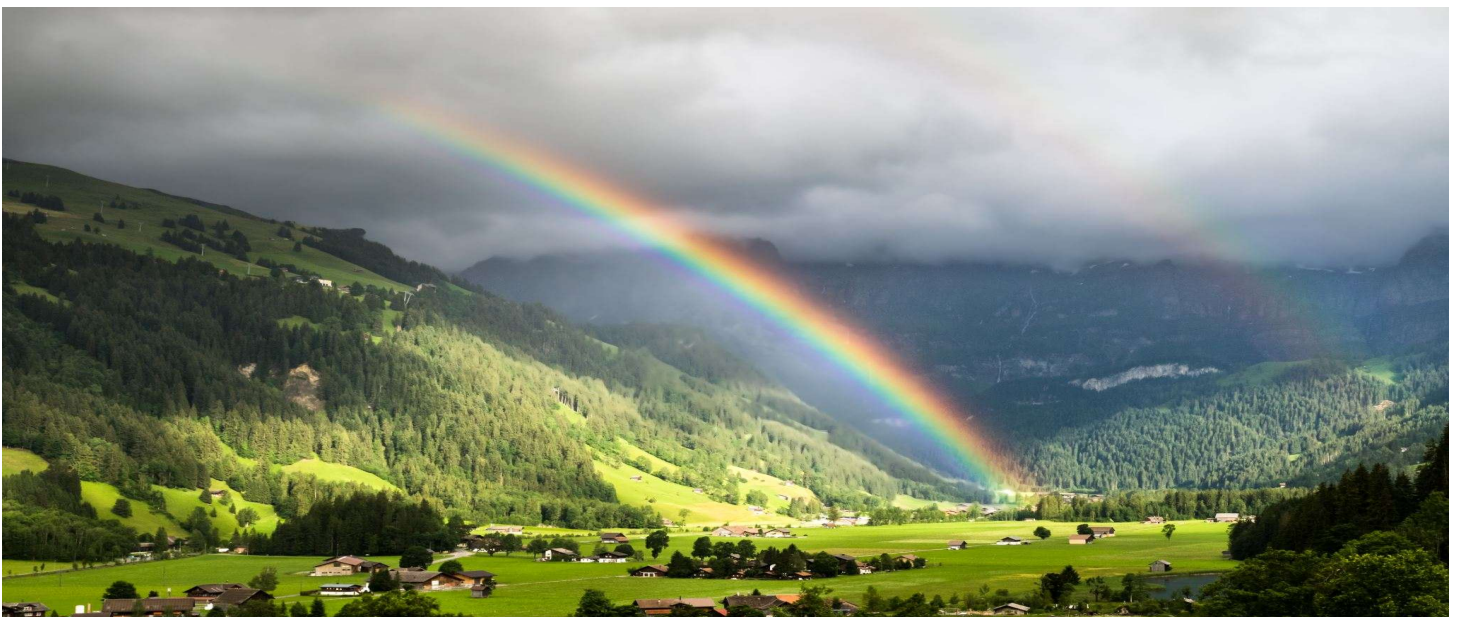

1. Log in to Ministry Manager at <https://ministrymanager.upperroom.org/>. If you do not already have an account, you will have to create one.
2. Near the upper-right corner of your web browser window, click on “My Account.”
3. Ensure the “Profile” tab under your name is selected.
4. Review your account information, to include your email address. Update any information to bring your record current.
5. At the bottom of the window, click “Save.” Please do not click “Change Account Info.” Feel free to explore the other tabs next to the Profile tab and add your Church and anyone you have Sponsored.
